THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE

(Chapter 258)

UNDER SECTION 13 OF THE ANIMAL DISEASES ORDINANCE, I
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Hog Cholera) (No. 2) Order 1973, and shall come into operation forthwith.
2. All animals and meats and meat products whether fresh, frozen, chilled or dried, fittings, utensils, pens, crates and other animal containers, hides, skins, horns, hair, wool, dehydrated or fresh blood, bones and bonemeal, tankage, hoofs, fodder, non-sterilised or pasteurised milk and other dairy products, and manure and other animal waste shall not be brought into Guyana from any of the countries set out in the Schedule.
3. Clauses 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of the Foot and Mouth Disease (Prohibition and Importation) Order* shall, for the purposes of this Order, *mutatis mutandis* apply subject to the modification, that is to say, references in that Order to a schedule shall be construed as references to the Schedule to this Order.
