THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

(Chapter 280)

IN PURSUANCE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5A OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

- 1. This Order, which amends the Purchase Tax (Motor Cars) Order 1973*, may be cited as the Purchase Tax (Motor Cars) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 1973.
 - 2. The Principal Order shall, in so far as it applies
 - (a) a rate of tax of thirty-six and one-half per cent in respect of a motor car with engine capacity of 1800 c.c. and above; and
 - (b) a rate of tax of twenty-four and one-half per cent in respect of a motor car with engine capacity less than 1800 c.c.

be construed and have effect as if there is applied in lieu thereof on or after the coming into operation of this Order a rate of tax of —

- (i) fifty-one and one-half per cent in respect of a motor car with engine capacity of more than 1800 c.c.;
- (ii) thirty-nine and one-half per cent in respect of a motor car with engine capacity of more than 1600 c.c. and not more than 1800 c.c.;
- (iii) twenty-four and one-half per cent in respect of a motor car with engine capacity of not more than 1600 c.c.
