THE EXCHANGE CONTROL ACT

(Cap. 86:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 33 OF THE EXCHANGE CONTROL ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Exchange Control (Import and Export) (Amendment) Order 1974.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects —

(a) by the substitution of the following paragraph for paragraph (1) of clause 2 —

“(1) There shall be exempted from the provisions of section 23(1) of the Act the importation into Guyana by a traveller who has exported from Guyana notes which are legal tender in Guyana of the maximum value authorised by clause 3(1) (a) like notes of the said maximum value.”;

b) by the substitution of the figures “15.00” for the figures “100.00” in clause 3(1) (a).

3. This Order shall not apply to a person who on his departure from Guyana prior of the commencement of this Order exported from Guyana notes which are legal tender in Guyana of an amount authorised by the Principal Order before such commencement and who on his return thereto after such commencement imports into Guyana by reason of such exportation notes of an amount not exceeding the amount so authorised.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits the importation into Guyana and the exportation therefrom of Guyana dollars exceeding \$15.00 in value.
