Citation.

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment- (No. 5) Order 1974.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended —

- (a) by the substitution in Part A of the Fourth Schedule thereto, for the particulars specified in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, thereto in relation to the article of manufacture numbered 45(c) Toilet Soap, of the particulars specified in the third, fourth and fifth columns respectively of Part A of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the same article of manufacture and to the said number; and
- (b) by the substitution in Part B of the Fourth Schedule thereto, for the particulars specified in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, thereto in relation to the article of manufacture numbered 45(c) Toilet Soap, of the particulars specified in the third, fourth and fifth columns respectively, of Part B of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the same article of manufacture and to the said number.
