THE TRADE ACT

(Chapter 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of Import and Export) Order*, may be cited as the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (Amendment) (No. 6) Order 1974. Citation..

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects — Amendment of the Principal Order.

(a) by the deletion of clause 2 and the substitution of the following clause therefor —

Import licence

2. Subject to clause 4, no goods shall be imported into Guyana after the coming into force of this clause except under the authority of a licence (hereinafter referred to as "import licence) granted by the Competent Authority."

(b) by the substitution in clause 3 —

(i) of the figure "4" for the figure "6"; and

(ii) of the word "First" for the word "Second";

(c) by the deletion of clauses 4 and 5;

(d) by renumbering clauses 6 to 11 as clauses 4 to 9, respectively;

(e) by the substitution of the words "2 and 3" for the words "2, 3, 4 and 5" in clause 4

(f) by the substitution of the word "Second" for the word "Third" in clause 5;

- (g) by the deletion of clause 9 and the substitution of the following clause therefor —

“Exemption. 9. This Order shall not apply to the importation or exportation of goods which, by virtue of the provisions of the Privileges and Immunities (Diplomatic, Consular and International Organisations) Act 1970, are not subject to the restrictions imposed by this Order.”;

- (h) by the deletion of the First Schedule; and
- (i) by redesignating the Second and Third Schedules as the First and Second Schedules, respectively.”
