THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Road and Roads Laboratory) Order, 1974.
2. The proposed construction of a road and roads laboratory on the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a public work.
3. The Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer, together with his agents, servants and workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of such land for the construction of the public work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

A portion of land being part of Plantation Thomas situate in Georgetown, in the County of Demerara, Guyana and bounded as follows:—

“On the North by Carifesta Avenue, Georgetown, on the south by Lamaha Street, Georgetown, on the east by Vlissengen Road, Georgetown and on the West by an imaginary line parallel to and 500 feet (five hundred feet) to the West of the centre line of Vlissengen Road, Georgetown.”
