THE TRADE ACT

(Cap. 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 58) Order 1974.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended — Amendment of the Principal Order.
