THE TRADE ACT  
(Cap. 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Bread) Order 1974 and shall be construed and read with the Trade (Control of Prices) Order\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order. Citation.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on 9th September, 1974.

2. In this Order — In-  
pretation.  
“bread” means white bread in the production of which, white flour of wheat is used, but does not include fruit loaves or bun loaves; “pre-packaged” means the pre-packaging of bread (otherwise than wrapping by a retailer for the purpose of sale by retail by him on the premises on which the bread is so wrapped) in advance ready for sale by retail.

3. The maximum price at which bread described in the first column of the Schedule shall be sold by retail shall be the price specified in relation to that description in the second, third and fourth columns, respectively, of the said Schedule. Maximum

4. (1) No retailer shall sell, offer or expose for sale, bread unless the bread is pre-packaged or wrapped for the purposes of sale by retail on the premises on which the bread is so wrapped. Pre-  
wrapping  
of bread.

(2) No charge additional to the maximum price specified in this Order shall be made for the pre-packaging of bread or for wrapping for the purposes of sale by retail on the premises on which the bread is so wrapped.

5. No retailer shall sell, offer or expose for sale, bread unless he has — Provisions  
as to Scales  
and Weights.

(a) fixed in some conspicuous place part of his shop, weights and measures duly stamped in order that bread may, from time to time, be weighed in the presence of the purchaser; or

(b) labelled the bread so as to indicate the weight and the price thereof.
