IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order* may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 84) Order 1974. Citation.
2. The Principal Order is hereby amended — Amendment

 - (b) by the substitution in Part B of the Fourth Schedule thereto, for the particulars specified in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, thereto in relation to the article numbered 1 (Butter), of the particulars specified in the third, fourth and fifth columns, respectively, in Part B of the Schedule to this Order in relation to the same article and to the said number.
