THE TRADE ACT

(Cap. 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order*, may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. 18) Order 1975.

2. Paragraph (1) of clause 8 of the Principal Order is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor —

“(1) No person carrying on a wholesale business which includes the selling for use or consumption in Guyana of any price controlled article shall without reasonable cause refuse to sell for cash by wholesale to any retailer any such article which forms part of the stock of the business.”

3. Paragraph (1) of clause 12 of the Principal Order is hereby deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor —

“(1) No person carrying on a retail business which includes the selling for use or consumption in Guyana of any price controlled article shall without reasonable cause refuse to sell for cash to any person any such article which forms part of the stock of the business.”
