THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Mechanical Workshop) Order 1975.

2. The proposed Construction of a Mechanical Workshop on the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a Public Work.

3. The Chief Works and Hydraulics Officer, together with his agents, servants and workmen, is hereby authorised to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or part of such land for the construction of the Public Work aforesaid.

SCHEDULE

A portion of land being part of Plantation Houston, situate on the East Bank of the Demerara River, in the county of Demerara and bounded as follows:—

- ON THE NORTH: By the centre line of the Old Navigation Canal extending from the East Bank Demerara Public Road, to the old Sugar Factory, and its prolongation to the Demerara River.
- ON THE EAST: By the East Bank Demerara Public Road.
- ON THE SOUTH: By the common boundary between Plantations Houston and Rome.
- ON THE WEST: By the Channel of the Demerara River.
