THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ACT

(CHAPTER 64:03)

UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE DRAINAGE AND IRRIGATION ACT, I
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Ascertainment, Determination and Suitability for Drainage) (No. 2) Order 1975.
2. The Drainage and Irrigation Board shall ascertain and determine whether the area, or any part thereof, described in the Schedule is suitable for and will be benefited by drainage and irrigation or drainage or irrigation.
3. The daily newspaper in which this Order is to be published shall be "The Daily Chronicle".

SCHEDULE

That area of land situate between the common boundary between the JOHANNA CECELIA — MARIA'S LODGE and the SUPENAAM RIVER and bounded as follows:—

- On the North — By the common boundary between JOHANNA CECELIA and MARIA'S LODGE, commencing at a point on its intersection of the western boundary of MARIA'S LODGE ESTATE and extending to its intersection with a point on the Mean High Water Mark of the Atlantic Ocean.
- On the South — By the left bank of the TAPAKUMA CREEK commencing at a point on the back boundary of the estate adjacent to and immediately north of the aforesaid creek, and extending along the left bank of the TAPAKUMA CREEK to its intersection with the left bank of the Supenaam River, thence along the said bank of the Supenaam River to its intersection with the Mean High Water Mark of the Atlantic Ocean.

On the East — By the line marking the Mean High Water Mark of the Atlantic Ocean and extending from a point between the line forming the common boundary between JOHANNA CECELIA and MARIA'S LODGE and extending in a southerly direction along the aforesaid Mean High Water Mark of the Atlantic Ocean, to its intersection with a point on the left bank of the Supenaam River.

On the West — By the prolongation of a line along the back boundaries of all the Estates, commencing from JOHANNA CECELIA ESTATE, and extending along the aforesaid line forming the back boundary in a southerly direction to a point on its intersection with the left bank of the TAPAKUMA CREEK.
