THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) Order 1975, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st February, 1975.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution of the following clause for clause 4 —

“Allowances
for
Chauffeurs.

4. Every judge of the Supreme Court, the Ombudsman, the Director of Public Prosecutions and the Director of Audit, shall be paid an allowance by way of an amount on the salary scale A7 (\$171 x \$11 — \$226 x \$12 — \$262 per month) to be determined by the Minister to meet the expenses incurred by him in respect of the employment of a chauffeur.”
