ORDER  
MADE UNDER  
THE CUSTOMS ACT  
(CHAPTER 82:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Exemption from Duties) Order 1975. Citation.

2. Item 13 of List A Part III of the First Schedule to the Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "8%" and "5½%" appearing in the columns headed General and Preferential respectively, of the words "5%" and "Free". Amendment of the First Schedule of the Principal Order.

3. Item 4 of List B (1) of Part III of the First Schedule to the Act is hereby amended in the following respects —

(a) by the substitution for paragraph (26) thereof, of the following paragraph —

“(26) Materials which are not obtainable in Guyana being not manufactured or produced therein, and which the Comptroller considers to be raw materials for use in the manufacture of bed sheets, garments, handkerchiefs and pillow cases.”

(b) by the substitution of the words “surface active preparations” for the word “detergents” appearing at the end of paragraph (35) thereof;

(c) by the substitution for paragraph (38) thereof, of the following paragraph —

“(38) Mild steel and galvanised mild steel wire, bars and rods which the Comptroller is

satisfied are solely for use in the manufacture of welded reinforcement mesh, welded galvanised netting, chain link fencing and chains”.

(d) by the addition thereto immediately after paragraph (54) thereof of the following paragraphs —

“(55) Materials which the Comptroller is satisfied are solely for use in the manufacture of refrigerators.

(56) Materials which are not obtainable in Guyana, being not manufactured or produced therein, and which the Comptroller considers to be raw materials for use in the manufacture of jams, marmalades and jellies.

(57) Materials which are not obtainable in Guyana, being not manufactured or produced therein, and which the Comptroller considers to be raw materials for use in the manufacture of roasted or salted peanuts and peanut butter.

(58) Materials which are not obtainable in Guyana being not manufactured or produced therein, and which the Comptroller considers to be raw materials for use in the manufacture of tomato ketchup.

(59) Materials which are not obtainable in Guyana, being not manufactured or produced therein, and which the Comptroller considers to be raw material for use in the manufacture of wigs and similar hair pieces.

(60) Materials which are not obtainable in Guyana, being not manufactured or produced therein, and which the Comptroller considers to be raw materials for use in the manufacture of medicaments.”

4. Item 5 of list B1 of Part III of the First Schedule is hereby amended by the substitution therefor of the following as Item 5:—

“(5) Fishing boats, equipment for fishing boats, equipment for fishing, fuel and lubricants, which the Comptroller is satisfied are imported solely for use in the fishing Industry.”
