THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Engineering Command Headquarters, Guyana Defence Force) Order 1976*, made on the 25th day of March, 1976. the proposed construction of the Engineering Command Headquarters of the Guyana Defence Force was declared to be a public work in accordance with section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WHEREAS, by the said Order the Chief Works Officer tegether with his agents, servants or workmen was authorised in accordance with section 4 of the said Act to enter upon the said lands for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or a part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer and a plan of the land to be acquired have been laid before the Minister;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the land described in the schedule to this Order is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Land for Public Purposes (the Engineering Command Headquarters, Guyana Defence Force) (Kitty, Georgetown) Order 1976.

SCHEDULE

A portion of land known as area "G" being the southern portion of a piece of land 1 acre and 40 sq. rods (one acre and forty sq. rods) in area, known as Lot 7 situate at the south-eastern corner of the intersection of Vlissengen Road and Station Street, Kitty, Georgetown, Demerara and bounded as follows:

Commencing from a concrete paal M.W.H. situate at its south-western corner 273.62 ft. measured south of the centre line of Station Street Kitty, parallel to Vlissengen Road and 47.00 ft. east of the centre line of Vlissengen Road measured along the western prolongation of the southern boundary and its boundary extends thus —

N 16° 33′ 00" (tr.) for 172.80 ft. to a wooden paal S.S.R.I.; thence N 106° 33′ 00" (tr.) for a distance of 210.05 ft. to a wooden paal S.S.R.I., thence N 196° 33′ 00" (tr.) for a distance of 172.80 ft. to a wooden paal S.S.R.I.; thence N 286° 33′ 00" (tr.) for a distance of 210.05 ft. back to the concrete paal M.W.H. at the point of commencement. The said area 'G' contains an area of 0.8332 of an acre and is shown bordered red on a plan by K. N. Maraj, Sworn Land Surveyor dated 21st June, 1976, and recorded at the Department of Lands and Surveys of the Ministry of Agriculture as Plan No. 17122 on 3rd August, 1976.
