THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Chapter 62:05)

WHEREAS, by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Construction of Government offices and housing quarters) (Carib Hotel) Order, 1976* made on the 14th day of May, 1976, the proposed construction of Government offices and quarters to house personnel in the service of the Government on the land described in the Schedule to that Order was declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Act;

AND WHEREAS, by the said Order, the Chief Works Officer together with his agents, servants and workmen, was authorised under section 4 of the Act to enter upon the said land for the purpose of surveying or otherwise examining such land with a view to the acquisition of the whole or a part thereof for the construction of the public work aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer and a plan of the land to be acquired has been laid before the Minister:

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the land described in the Schedule to this Order together with the building and erections thereon, is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government offices and housing quarters) (Carib Hotel) Order 1976.

A parcel of land, comprising portions of the front lands of Plantations Sophia and Li iendaal, Georgetown, Demerara, situate between the Public Road and the Sea Defence commonly known as the Sea Wall, and commencing from a concrete paal M.W.H. situate at its south western corner, the said paal being 43.0 feet north of the centre line of the Public Road measured along the southern prolongation of the western boundary, and 764.8 feet measured east of the centre line of the street immediately west of the Bel Air Hotel Compound, and along the centre line of the Public Road and extending—

N209°26′00" (Tr.) for a distance of 162.84 feet, thence
N204°26′00" (Tr.) for a distance of 21.00 feet, and thence
N262°31′00" (Tr.) for 282.95 feet back to the point of commencement,
