BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE, 1962,
(No. 23 of 1962).

UNDER SECTION 34 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE, 1962, THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Corporations (Guyana School of Agriculture) Order, 1964.

2. There shall be established a school to be known as the Guyana School of Agriculture (hereinafter referred to as "the School") which shall be a public corporation consisting of one official member and eight other members appointed by the Minister for the time being responsible for agriculture.

3.(1) It shall be the duty of the School —

- (a) to train persons in the theory and practice of agriculture;
- (b) to manage, develop and operate farms and undertakings of an agricultural nature —
 - (i) to provide part of the training offered by the School; and
 - (ii) as commercial farms and undertakings in accordance with good farming practice subject however to the provisions of (i) aforesaid.

(2) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the provisions of the preceding paragraph the School shall have power —

- (a) to determine and provide the standards of training to be maintained in the School;
- (b) to determine the examinations to be set and the diplomas and certificates to be awarded by the School;
- (c) to award, and when awarded, to withdraw scholarships;
- (d) to establish, maintain and operate nurseries, workshops or other work in connection with the School, the farms or the undertakings;
- (e) to conduct experiments and undertake research.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order, provides for the establishment and incorporation under the provisions of the Public Corporations Ordinance, 1962, of the Guyana School of Agriculture. The School will be responsible for the training of persons in the theory and practice of agriculture, and will manage, develop and operate on a commercial basis farms and other undertakings of an agricultural nature.
