ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1964.
(No. 8 of 1964).

UNDER REGULATION 42 OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1964, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE DEPUTY TO THE GOVERNOR :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Curfew) Order, 1964.

2. No person in the area specified in the Schedule hereto shall, between the hours of 7 p.m. of any day and 5 a.m. of the following day, be out of doors except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Police Officer commanding "E" Division.

3. This Order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of May, 1964.

SCHEDULE

CURFEW AREA

The portion of the Colony in the West Demerara District bounded as follows:—

The Left Bank of the Demerara River commencing obliquely opposite the Kara Kara River at the Burial Ground North of Section "C", Christianburg, and extending up the Demerara River to Karia Creek at Section "A" Wismar, with a Mean depth inland of 1 mile.
