THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. (Chapter 280)

UNDER SECTION 47 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE HAS MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR ACTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF:—

- 1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Road Traffic (Campbellville) (One-Way Streets) (Amendment) Order, 1964, and shall be construed and read as **one** with the Road Traffic (Campbellville) (One-Way Streets) Order, 1962, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order.
 - (2) This Order shall come into operation on the 15th day of June, 1964.
 - 2. Article 6 of the Principal Order is hereby revoked.
