THE SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT (SETTING ASIDE OR ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY) REGULATIONS, 1964.

UNDER REGULATION 2 OF THE SPECIAL SERVICE UNIT (SETTING ASIDE OR ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY) REGULATIONS, 1964, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Special Service Unit (Setting Aside of Land) Order, 1964.
2. The area of land defined in the schedule to this Order is hereby set aside for the use of the Special Service Unit.

SCHEDULE

The area of land situate at and being a part of Plantation Thomas known as the Rifle Ranges and bounded as follows —

- On the north — by the southern edge of the Sea Wall Public Road.
- On the south — by the northern edge of the trench on the northern side of Thomas Road.
- On the east — by the western edge of the trench on the western side of Vlissengen Road.
- On the west — by the eastern boundary of the area held by the Imperial and International Communications, Limited, and its prolongation northwards.
