THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1964.

(No. 8 of 1964)

UNDER REGULATION 63A(1) OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 1964, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING ME IN THAT BEHALF, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Restriction of Bail) Order, 1964.
2. The offences specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby prescribed to be specified offences for the purposes of paragraph (1) of regulation 63A of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1964.

SCHEDULE

SPECIFIED OFFENCES

All offences against regulation 49A of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 1964.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The effect of this Order is that bail cannot be granted, without the consent of the Commissioner of Police, to persons charged with unlawful possession of firearms, ammunition and explosives and other kindred offences.
