MADE UNDER

THE INCOME TAX (IN AID OF INDUSTRY) ORDINANCE
(Chapter 300)

UNDER SECTION 1(2) OF THE INCOME TAX (IN AID OF INDUSTRY) ORDINANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Income Tax (In Aid of Industry) Order, 1964.

2. The first schedule to the Income Tax (In Aid of Industry) Ordinance*, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the substitution of a comma for the full stop at the end of item 4 and the insertion thereafter of the following articles —

“pigments, paints, varnishes, painters’ fillings, and painting products.”
