THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958,  
(No. 34 of 1958).

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ORDINANCE, 1958, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR'S DEPUTY AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade (Control of Imports and Exports) (No. 2) Order, 1964, and shall be construed and read as one with the Trade (Control of Import and Export) (No. 2) Order, 1963\*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, and any Order amending the same.
2. The first schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended —
  - (a) by the deletion of the words "not canned" wherever they appear against item 012 01;
  - (b) by the insertion of the following against item 013—02—"Bacon, in airtight containers.;" and
  - (c) by the deletion of the words and brackets "(other than toilet soap)" appearing against item 552—02.
