

ORDER IN COUNCIL UNDER THE PENSIONS REGULATIONS, 1933, CONTAINED IN THE SCHEDULE TO THE PENSIONS ORDINANCE, 1933, (NO. 20 OF 1933) VARYING SCHEDULES I. AND II. TO THE REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS it is provided by the Pensions Regulations, 1933 :—

- (a) under Regulation 2 thereof that the Governor may by Order in Council vary Schedule I. to the said Regulations by the addition thereto or the removal of any Government ; and
- (b) under Regulation 20 thereof, that Schedule II. may be varied by Order in Council by the addition thereto or the removal therefrom of any Government ;

And whereas it is expedient that Schedules I. and II. to the above recited Regulations should be varied by the removal and addition of the names of certain Governments :

Now, therefore, the Governor in exercise of the powers by the above recited Regulations in him vested and of all other powers in him thereunto enabling, by and with the advice of the Executive Council doth hereby order that Schedules I. and II. to the Pensions Regulations, 1933, be varied as follows :—

- (a) By the addition to Schedule I. of the words—
“ Hong Kong.
Kenya and Uganda Railways and Harbours.
Trinidad.”
- (b) By the deletion from Schedule II. of the words—
“ Kenya-Uganda Railways and Harbours Administration.
Trinidad.”
