ORDER IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 35 OF THE ANIMALS (BREED AND CONTAGIOUS DISEASES) ORDINANCE, 1932.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 2 of the Animals (Breed and Contagious Diseases) Ordinance, 1932, that whenever in the opinion of the Governor in Council a case of emergency arises, the Governor in Council may exercise any of the powers conferred on the Board of Agriculture by the Animals (Breed and Contagious Diseases) Ordinance, Cap. 272;

And whereas it is provided by section 35 (10) of the Animals (Breed and Contagious Diseases) Ordinance, Cap. 272, that the Board, whenever it appears expedient to do so, may make any general or special orders, as they may deem fit, for the purpose of, in any manner, preventing the spread of disease;

And whereas the occurrence of paralytic Rabies among certain animals has been reported in Trinidad:

Now, therefore, the Governor by virtue of the powers conferred by the said above recited sections, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby order and declare that cats shall not be landed in this Colony from Trinidad until further notice.
