ORDER IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 12 OF THE DESTITUTE AND CRIMINAL IMMIGRANTS ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 209, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 3 OF THE DESTITUTE AND CRIMINAL IMMIGRANTS ORDINANCE, 1934 (NO. 10 OF 1934), SUBSTITUTING A NEW FORM FOR THE FORM CONTAINED IN THE SCHEDULE TO THE ORDINANCE, CHAPTER, 209.

Whereas it is enacted by section 12 of the Destitute and Criminal Immigrants Ordinance, Chapter 209, as amended by section 3 of the Destitute and Criminal Immigrants Ordinance, 1934, (No. 10 of 1934), that the master of any vessel arriving in the colony shall furnish the harbour master with a list of passengers in the form in the schedule thereto, or in such form as the Governor in Council may by notice in the Gazette prescribe;

And whereas it is expedient that a new form be prescribed in place of the form in the schedule to the Ordinance:

Now, therefore, the Governor by and with the advice of the Executive Council, in pursuance of the hereinbefore recited powers conferred on him, doth hereby prescribe the form set out in the schedule hereto as the form in which the list of passengers shall be furnished to the harbour master by the master of any vessel arriving in the colony, to be substituted for the form in the schedule to the Ordinance.
