ORDER IN COUNCIL UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE FOOD PRICE REGULATION ORDINANCE, 1934 (No. 1 OF 1934) PRESCRIBING THE MAXIMUM PRICES AT WHICH CERTAIN ARTICLES OF FOOD AND FUEL SHALL BE SOLD IN THIS COLONY.

Whereas, it is enacted by section 3 of the Food Prices Regulation Ordinance, 1934, that the Governor in Council may, if he considers it necessary to prevent any undue increase in the prices of food or in any article used as fuel, by Order prescribe the maximum price at which any articles of food or used as fuel, may be sold in any district either by wholesale or by retail;

And whereas, it appears desirable, as a result of the conditions in the Colony caused by floods, to prescribe the maximum prices at which certain articles of food and fuel shall be sold:

Now, therefore, the Governor by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby order and prescribe that the prices stated in respect of the following articles of food and fuel set out in the Schedule hereto shall be the maximum prices at which the said articles shall be sold.
