

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE  
PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES (DIPLOMATIC, CONSULAR AND  
INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS) ACT, I MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

- Citation.           1. This Order may be cited as the Privileges and Immunities (Republic of Peru) Order  
                          2008.
- Exemption           2. On and from the date on which the Agreement between the Government of the  
from                   Republic of Peru and the Government of the Co-operative Republic of Guyana for the  
requirement         Abolition of Visas for Diplomatic, Service, Official and Special Passport Holders  
of visa.             signed at New York, U.S.A. on the 25<sup>th</sup> September 2007 comes into operation, the  
                          citizens of Peru who are holders of diplomatic, service, official and special passports  
                          issued by the Government of the Republic of Peru are exempt from the requirement of  
                          possession of a visa issued by the Government of Guyana for entry into Guyana and  
                          remaining in Guyana for a period not exceeding ninety days from the date of entry into  
                          Guyana unless that period is extended by the Government of Guyana.
