| Citation | 1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission (State Mining Reserve) Order 2008 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 9 th day of June, 2007. |
| Designation of State Mining Reserve | 2. The area hereinafter described in the Schedule below is hereby declared a State Mining Reserve, and is hereby reserved for prospecting or mining of gold, diamonds, valuable minerals or precious stones by the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission, but WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the power of the Minister (as representing the State) to permit any person to carry on in the scheduled area mining or prospecting operations (including operations incidental thereto) for the benefit, wholly or partly, of the Guyana Geology and Mines Commission |

SCHEDULE


Tract of state land located in the Mazaruni Mining District No. 3 as shown on Terra Surveys Topographic Map 27NE, 1:50,000 with reference point "X" located at the confluence of the Mazaruni and Turtruba Rivers located with geographical coordinates of Longitude 58°42'23"W and latitude 6°18'23"N

Thence at a true bearing of 201°, for a distance of 1 mile 164 yards, to the point of commencement

Point A, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 58°42'44"W and latitude 6°17'30"N, thence at true bearing of 277°, for a distance of approximately 1 mile 35 yards, to Point B, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 58°43'37"W and latitude 6°17'36"N, thence downstream along the left bank of the Mazaruni River, for a distance of approximately 4 miles 172 yards, to Point C, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 58°42'52"W and latitude 6°20'6"N, thence at true bearing of 122°, for a distance of approximately 1615 yards, to Point D, located at geographical coordinates of longitude 58°42'11"W and latitude 6°19'40"N, thence upstream along the right bank of the Mazaruni River for a distance of approximately 3 miles 470 yards, to the point of commencement at Point A.

Thus enclosing an area of approximately 2771 acres, save and except all lands lawfully held and occupied.
