IN THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 5 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ACT 1988 I MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER: -

- Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the National Industrial and Commercial Investment Limited (Vesting of Property) Order 2010.
- Interpretation. 2. In this Order-

- (a) "NICIL" means National Industrial and Commercial Investments Limited, being a company incorporated in Guyana under the provisions of the Companies Act and continued under the Companies Act 1991 with registered office situated at 126 Barrack Street, Kingston, Georgetown, Demerara;
- Schedule. (b) "Property" means the property described in the Schedule belonging to the State.
- Transfer of Property. 3. The Property described in the Schedule, owned by the Government on behalf of the State is hereby vested in NICIL.

SCHEDULE

BLOCK called "ALPHA" being a portion of State Land located at the North Western Part of Kingston contiguous to the Atlantic Ocean and the Demerara River, Kingston, Georgetown, in the County of Demerara, in the Republic of Guyana containing an area of 6.88 (six decimal eight eight) acres as shown on a plan numbered 43130 by Leon Rutherford, Sworn Land Surveyor dated the 28th day of May 2008.
