THE TRADE ACT

(Cap. 91:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order\*, may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No. ) Order 1989.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the particulars specified in the respective columns of Parts A and B of the Fourth Schedule in relation to the articles numbered 10 (Split Peas), 48 (Crash helmets), 50 (TRADE TOOLS), 51 (BUILDING MATERIALS AND FITTINGS) with the exception of Hardboard, familiarly known as tentest, Plywood, Chipboard or particle board, 52 (Footwear with uppers of textile fabric), 53 (Sports gear), 62 Mining equipment/Implement), 63 (Barley), 64 (Sago), 67 (Instant tea), 70 (Kite paper) and 74 (Motor vehicle tyres).

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order decontrols the prices of split peas, crash helmets, trade tools, building materials and fittings, with the exception of hardboard or tentest, plywood, chipboard or particle board, footwear with uppers of textile fabric, sports gear, mining equipment/implement, barley, sago, instant tea, kite paper and motor vehicle tyres.
