## THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

Cap. 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government School Buildings) (No. 3) Order 1989, No. 51 of 1989, made on the 12th day of September, 1989 the proposed utilisation or modification of the existing buildings and erections and the construction of any new buildings on the land described in the schedule to that Order were declared to be a public work under Section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WHEREAS by the said Order the Commissioner of Lands and Surveys, together with his agents, servants and workmen was authorised under section 4 of the Act to enter upon the said land for the purposes therein mentioned;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer together with a plan of the land to be acquired was laid before the Minister;

AND WHEREAS the Minister has deemed it advisable to declare that the said land is required for the public work aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the land described in the Schedule to this Order is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government School Buildings) (No. 6) Order 1989.

#### SCHEDULE

That parcel of land called Tract 'B', being a portion of land of section A, Liverpool, situate on the Corentyne Coast, Berbice, in the Republic of Guyana, together with the buildings and erections thereon, surveyed and defined on a plan by R.T. John, Sworn Land Surveyor dated 22nd September, 1989 and recorded on the 28th September, 1989 at the Department of Lands and Surveys, Georgetown as Plan No. 22576.

The boundaries of the said Tract 'B' commence at a pipe set in concrete branded R.T.J. marking the south—east corner of the said Tract 'B' and being 1289.7 ft from the centre line of the Corentyne Public Road and extend thence N 15 48' (T) for a distance of 330.0 ft to a wood paal branded R.T.J.; thence N 285 48' (T) for a distance of 370.0 ft to a wood paal branded R.T.J.; thence N 195 48' (T) for a distance of 330.0 ft to a wood paal branded R.T.J.; thence N 105 48' (T) for a distance of 370.0 ft to the pipe set in concrete branded R.T.J. marking the point of commencement.

The said Tract 'B' on the aforesaid plan, contains an area of 2.8 acres.
