## ORDER

#### THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

# (Cap. 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government School Buildings) (No. 2) Order 1989, No. 50 of 1989, made on the 12th day of September, 1989 the proposed utilisation or modification of the existing buildings and creations and the construction of any new buildings on the land described in the Schedule to that Order were declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WIEREAS by the said Order the Commissioner of Lands and Surveys, together with his agents, servants and workmen was authorised under section 4 of the Act to enter upon the said land for the purposes therein mentioned;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer together with a plan of the land to be acquired was laid before the Minister;

AND WHEREAS the Minister has deemed it advisable to declare that the said land is required for the public work aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the and described in the Schedule to this Order is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government School Buildings) (No. 5) Order 1989.

### SCHEDULE

That parcel of land called Tract 'A' being a portion of Block 1, Plantation Westbury, situate on the Essequibo Coast, in the county of Essequibo in the Republic of Guyana, together with the buildings and erections thereon, 'surveyed and defined on a plan by C.C. Cappel, Sworn Land Surveyor dated 5th October, 1989 and recorded on the l2th October, 1989 at the Department of Lands and Surveys, Georgetown as Plan No. 22587.

The boundaries of the said Tract 'A' commence at a wood paal w branded C.C.C. marking the north-eastern corner of Tract 'A' and being 41.00 ft. from the centre-line of the all weather road between Plantation Westbury and Plantation Dartmouth and 174.00 ft. from the prolongated centre-line of the Public Road and its boundaries extend thence N 229<sup>o</sup> 25' 00" (T) 376.00 ft., thence N 317<sup>o</sup> 12' 30" (T): 400.00 ft, thence N 49<sup>o</sup> 25' 00" (T) 376.00 ft, and thence N 137<sup>o</sup> 12' 30" (T) 400.00 ft, to the point of commencement

The said parcel of land shown on the aforesaid plan, contains an area of 3.45 acres.
