THE INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT

(Cap. 2:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE PRESIDENT BY SECTION 27 OF THE INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

1. This Order may be cited as the Interpretation and General Clauses (Delegation of Functions) (No. 2) Order 1988.

2. I hereby delegate with effect from the commencement of this Order, the Minister in the Ministry of Health, to exercise on my behalf the functions conferred on me, consequent on being charged with responsibility for the administration of the Ministry of Home Affairs, by —

(a) the sections of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Control) Act 1988 specified in Part I of the Schedule; and

(b) the regulations of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Control) Regulations 1988 specified in Part II of the Schedule:

Provided that —

- (i) the aforesaid Minister shall consult me in respect of important policy matters concerning the functions so delegated to him; and
(ii) the power delegated to the aforesaid Minister by this Order shall not be deemed to include the power to make subsidiary legislation.
