THE LABOUR ACT

(Cap. 98:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 9A OF THE LABOUR ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Minimum Wages (Cinema Employees) Order*, may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Cinema Employees) (Amendment) Order 1988, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st December, 1988.

Citation and commencement.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution, for the Schedule, of the following Schedule —

Amendment of Schedule to the Principal Order.

SCHEDULE

Category of Employee	Minimum Wage Rates
Operators	\$250.00 per week
General Staff — under 18 years	\$150.00 per week
18 years old and over	\$193.00 per week
Cashiers	\$193.00 per week
Clerical Assistants	\$193.00 per week
Ticket Collectors	\$193.00 per week
Guards	\$193.00 per week
Sweepers/Cleaners	\$150.00 per week

*Cap. 98:01 Subsidiary Legislation.

The minimum rates of wages payable to a person employed during any period of time mentioned in this Schedule in more than one category of work set out above in respect of which different minimum rates of wages are set out, shall be the highest of such rates.

The minimum rate of wages payable to a person employed in any of the above categories of work for any shorter period of time than the appropriate period set out above shall be the appropriate minimum rate of wages set out, above in respect of the last mentioned period."
