THE CONSTITUTION

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY ARTICLE 47(4) OF THE CONSTITUTION, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

Citation. 1. This Order may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment) Order 1987.

Amendment of article 47 of the Constitution. 2. Article 47(3) of the Constitution is hereby amended in the following respects —

- (a) by the insertion, after the words “appies are”, of the words “Antigua and Barbuda.”;
- (b) by the insertion, after the words “Barbados,”, of the words “Belize.”;
- (c) by the insertion, after the words “Botswana,”, of the words “Brunei.”;
- (d) by the insertion, after the words “Malaysia,”, of the words “Maldives.”;
- (e) by the substitution, for the words “Saint Lucia, St. Vincent”, of the words “Saint Christopher and Nevis, Saint Lucia, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines.”;
- (f) by the insertion, after the words “United Kingdom and Colonies,”, of the words “Vanuatu.”;
- (g) by the substitution, for the words “and Zambia”, of the words “Zambia and Zimbabwe”.
