- IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 4 OF THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE the following order:—
- 1. This Order, which amends the Ministers, Members of Citation the National Assembly and Special Offices (Allowances) Order,* commencemay be cited as the Ministers, Members of the National Assembly and Special Offices (Allowances) (Amendment) Order 1987, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1987.

*Cap. 1:07 Subsidiary Legislation.

Amendment of Schedule to the Principal Order.

- 2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the substitution for subparagraphs (3) and (4) of paragraph 1 of the following subparagraphs as subparagraphs (3) and (4)
 - '(3) The Prime Minister, every other Minister, the Attorney General and the Speaker of the National Assembly shall each be entitled to employ two chauffeurs and shall be paid in respect of each chauffeur allowances at the following monthly rates to meet the expenses incurred by him in respect of the employment of the chauffeurs —

chauffeur of the Prime Minister ... \$1,089.35 chauffeur of every other Minister, other than a Minister of State, the Attorney-General and the Speaker of the National Assembly \$1,001.99

chauffeur of a Minister of State \$ 968.38

(4) Every Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to employ a chauffeur and shall be paid in respect of the chauffeur an allowance at the rate of \$968.38 per month to meet the expenses incurred by him in respect of the employment of the chauffeur.".
