IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER
BY SECTION 5 OF THE TRADE ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order, which amends the Trade (Control of Prices) Order*, may be cited as the Trade (Control of Prices) (Amendment) (No.1) Order 1986. Citation.
2. The Principal Order is hereby amended as follows:— Amendment of the Principal Order.
 - (a) in Parts A and B of the Fourth Schedule thereto, by the deletion of article numbered 22 (Garlic) and the particulars specified in the respective columns thereof;
 - (b) in Part A of the Sixth Schedule thereto by the insertion, after the article numbered 6 (Margarine), of the article and the particular specified in the respective columns of the Schedule to this Order.
