### Chauffeur allowance for 1986

(1) Where a chauffeur in employment on 1985 — 12 — 31 is continued in employment as such thereafter or a new chauffeur is employed in 1986.

The allowance as mentioned in the appropriate entry in the second column of Part A of Table I plus an increase by 5% of such sum as represents the basic salary in the aforesaid allowance.

(2) In addition to the allowance mentioned in item (1) with effect from 1986—01—01 such further sum, as may be awarded by the Minister responsible for finance in the last quarter of 1986 based on the actual appraisal of the work of the chauffeur.
