THE CONSTITUTION AL OFFICES (REMUNER TION OF HOLDERS) ACT

(Cap. 27:11)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICE (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ACT, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Citation and commencement.

1. (1) This Order, which amends the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) Order*, may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) (Amendment) rder 1986.

- (2) Clause 2(a) hall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January. 1984.
- Amendment of the Principal Order.
- 2. The Principal Order i hereby amended as follow
 - (a) by the substitution in clause 10(d) for the full stop of a semicolon and by the addition thereafter of the following paragraph as paragraph (e) "(e) to the Commissioner of Police at the rate of two hundred and fifty dollars per month."; and
 - (b) by the addition after clause 12 of the following clause as clause 13 —

"Increased Allowances for chauffeurs. 13. otwithstanding anything contained in clauses 5(1) and 11(ii), the allowances specified to be paid thereunder to the holders of the offices mentioned therein for the purpose of meeting the expenses incurred in respect of the employment of chaufteurs shall with effect from 1st January, 1985 be as mentioned in the Table below.

Where a new chauffeur is employed in 1985

\$745.92 plus an increase in the basic salary by such fraction of 4% as sobtained by dividing the number of days the chauffeur worked in 1985 by 365.

TABLE II

Chauffeur allowance for 1986

(1) Where a chauffeur in employment on 1985—12—31 is continued in employment as such thereafter or a new chauffeur is employed in 1986.

The allowance as mentioned in the appropriate entry in the second column of Part A of Table I plus an increase by 5% of such sum as represents the basic salary in the aforesaid allowance.

2) In addition to the allowance mentioned in item (1) with effect from 1986—01—01 such further sum, as may be awarded by the Minister responsible for finance in the last quarter of 1986, based on the actual appraisal of the work of the chauffeur.
