THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY  
AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ACT  
(Cap. 1:07)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER  
BY SECTION 8 OF THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL  
ASSEMBLY AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ACT, I  
HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Ministers, Members  
of the National Assembly and Special Offices (Emoluments)  
Order 1986 and shall be deemed to have come into operation  
on 1st January, 1986.

2. The Schedule to the Act is hereby amended as follows —

(a) in paragraph 1 —

(i) by the substitution for the words “\$50,000”,  
“\$50,400”, “\$42,000”, “\$30,000”, “18,000”,  
“\$12,000”, “\$50,400”, “\$9,600”, “\$24,000”, and  
“\$7,200” of the words “\$72,600”, “\$60,984”,  
“\$50,820”, “\$36,300”, “\$24,000”, “\$18,000”,  
“\$60,984”, “\$11,640”, “\$36,300”, and “\$8,760”  
respectively;

(ii) by the substitution for the full stop at the  
end of the proviso of a colon and by the in-  
sertion thereafter of the following proviso —  
“Provided further that the annual salary

for the period that commenced on 1st January, 1935 and ended on 31st December, 1935 with respect to such other Member of the National Assembly shall be \$7,920 per annum”;

(b) in paragraph 2, by the substitution for the words “\$4,800” where they occur for the second and third times of the words “\$6,000”;

(c) in paragraph 3, by the substitution for the words —  
“Minority Leader ... \$1,200 per annum”  
of the words  
“Minority Leader ... \$6,000 per annum”  
Every other member of the  
National Assembly ... \$3,000 per annum”;

(d) in paragraph 4, by the addition after subparagraph (e) of the following subparagraph as subparagraph (f) —

“(f) The Minority Leader is entitled to occupy free of rent a furnished residence provided by the Government, or in lieu thereof, he is entitled to be paid a house allowance of \$700 per month.”.
