THE ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT

(Cap. 62:05)

WHEREAS by the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government Buildings) Order 1985, No. 71 of 1985 made on the 16th day of November, 1985, the buildings and erections on the land described in the Schedule to that Order were declared to be a public work under section 3 of the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes Act;

AND WHEREAS by the said Order the Commissioner of Lands and Surveys, together with his agents, servants or workmen was authorised under section 4 of the Act to enter upon the said land for the purposes therein mentioned;

AND WHEREAS in accordance with the provisions of section 6 of the Act, the report of the Chief Works Officer together with a plan of the land to be acquired was laid before the Minister;

AND WHEREAS the Minister has deemed it advisable to declare that the said land is required for the public work aforesaid;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of the said section 6, it is hereby declared that the land described in the Schedule to this Order, is required for the public work aforesaid.

This Order may be cited as the Acquisition of Lands for Public Purposes (Government Buildings) Order 1986.

SCHEDULE

That parcel of land called tract 'A', being a portion of Plantation Belfield, situate on the East Coast of Demerara, in the Republic of Guyana, together with the buildings and erections thereon, surveyed and defined on a plan by Cde. J. Ramnauth, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated 23rd December, 1985, and recorded on the 6th February, 1986 at the Department of Lands and Surveys, Georgetown, as Plan No. 20999.

The boundaries of the said tract 'A' commence at a wood paal set in concrete and branded JR, marking the North Eastern corner of the said tract 'A' and the southern boundary of the Public Road Reserve and is situated N $174^{\circ} 50' 46''$ (tr) for a distance of 68.95 feet from the intersection of the centre lines of the concrete bridge on the east side line trench of Plantation Belfield and the public road, and extend thence N $192^{\circ} 04' 00''$ (tr.) for a distance of 421.50 feet to a wood paal branded JR, thence N $282^{\circ} 05' 00''$ (tr.) for a distance of 222.40 feet to a wood paal branded JR, thence N $13^{\circ} 40' 00''$ (tr.) for a distance of 429.75 feet to a wood paal branded JR, thence N $104^{\circ} 19' 46''$ (ded. tr.) for a distance of 210.63 feet to the wood paal set in concrete, branded JR to the point of commencement.

The said parcel of land shown bordered red on the aforesaid plan contains an area of 2.114 acres.
