

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSING ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 107).

UNDER THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSING ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

Under section 3(a) of the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Ordinance (Cap. 107) as substituted by section 3(a) of the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952†, and as further amended by section 2 of the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1952*, the area defined in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be an area in respect of which a second class off-licence may be issued.

SCHEDULE

Definition of Area.

An area 60 feet long by 40 feet wide situate immediately west of the western wall of the Spirit Warehouse situate on the premises of S. Davson and Company Limited, at Plantation Blairmont on the West Bank of the Berbice River, in the County of Berbice.
