## ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSING ORDINANCE (Chapter 107)

UNDER THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR LICENSING ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

Under section 3(a) of the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing Ordinance (Cap. 107) as substituted by section 3(a) of the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952†, and as further amended by section 2 of the Intoxicating Liquor Licensing (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, 1952\*, the area defined in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be an area in respect of which a second class off-licence may be issued.

## SCHEDULE

Definition of Area.

An area 120 feet long by 60 feet wide situate immediately east of the Distillery Spirit Store and south of the Sugar Factory at Plantation Uitviugt, West Coast, Demerara.
