

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, 1942,  
(No. 2 of 1942).

UNDER SECTION 8 (1) OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, 1942, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Hire Car Chauffeurs) Order, 1953.

2. In this Order—

“chauffeur” means a person employed to drive a hire car;

“normal hours” means the maximum number of hours which may normally be worked by a chauffeur in accordance with the Hours of Work (Georgetown and New Amsterdam Hire Car Chauffeurs) Regulations, 1953\*.

3. Subject to the provisions of this Order, the minimum rate of wage to be paid to a chauffeur shall be \$13.00 per week.

4. A chauffeur who, at the request of his employer, works in excess of the normal hours, shall be paid for every hour or part thereof so worked, at one and one-half times the rate at which he would, but for this Order, have been paid.

5. This Order shall apply—

(a) to the city of Georgetown as defined in section 4 of the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance and to the area within one mile of the boundaries thereof;

(b) to the town of New Amsterdam as defined in section 6 of the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, 1949.

6. This Order shall come into force on the twenty-third day of July, 1953.
