ORDER IN COUNCIL UNDER

SECTION 44 OF THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION (MAGISTRATES) ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 9.

WHEREAS it is enacted by subsection (1) of section 44 of the Summary Jurisdiction (Magistrates) Ordinance, Chapter 9, that the Governor may, by Order in Council, appoint the times and places for the sittings of the courts, other than the court of the Georgetown district, and may in like manner alter any of those times and places;

And whereas the Governor by Order in Council dated the 11th December, 1933, ordered and appointed the times and places of the sitting of the Magistrates' Courts in the East Demerara Judicial District;

And whereas it is desirable that the sittings of the said court holden at Vigilance in the said district should until further orders be held at Sparendaam:

Now therefore the Govenor-in-Council doth hereby order and appoint that the Magistrate's courtroom at Sparendaam be substituted for the Magistrate's courtroom at Vigilance as the place for the sitting of the Magistrate's court in the East Demerara Judicial District and the time for the sitting of the said court shall be every Thursday commencing from Thursday the 1st day of October, 1953.
