MADE UNDER

THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ORDINANCE, 1939,
(No. 31 of 1939).

UNDER SECTIONS 3, 4 AND 9A OF THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY ORDINANCE, 1939, AS AMENDED BY SECTIONS 3, 4 AND 8 OF THE TRADING WITH THE ENEMY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1947, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Trading with the Enemy (Enemy Territory Cessation) (Germany) Order, 1953.

2. For the purposes of this Order "Germany" means territory comprised in the German State on the 1st day of March, 1938.

3. Germany shall for all purposes of the Trading with the Enemy Ordinance, 1939, and for the purposes of any Order made thereunder cease to be treated as if it were enemy territory as from the date of this Order.
