

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, 1951,

(No. 40 of 1951).

UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE ANTIBIOTICS ORDINANCE, 1951. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Antibiotics (Terramycin, Neomycin and Erythomycin) Order, 1953.

2. The following are hereby declared to be antibiotics to which the provisions of the Antibiotics Ordinance, 1951, shall apply:—

Terramycin, all compounds of terramycin and all medicinal preparations containing terramycin; Neomycin, all compounds of neomycin and all medicinal preparations containing neomycin; and Erythomycin, all compounds of erythomycin and all medicinal preparations containing erythomycin.
