## MADE UNDER

THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1953.

UNDER SECTION 4 OF THE BRITISH GUIANA (CONSTITUTION) ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1953, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:—

- 1. The Ordinances set out in the second column of the First Schedule to this Order are hereby amended in the manner and to the extent shown in the third column of the said Schedule.
- 2.
