

ORDER IN COUNCIL

MADE UNDER

THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT
ORDINANCE

(Chapter 169).

UNDER THE DISTRICT LANDS PARTITION AND RE-ALLOTMENT
ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN
COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. Under section 4(1) of the above Ordinance, the land specified in the petition of Chiranjivsingh of Bush Lot, Corentyne, Berbice, and others, which said land is described in the Schedule hereto, shall be subject to the provisions of the above Ordinance.

2. Under section 5(1) (a) of the above Ordinance as amended by section 4(1) of the District Lands Partition and Re-allotment (Amendment) Ordinance, 1948, James Lawrence Yhap, Esquire, Sworn Land Surveyor, is hereby appointed to be the officer to partition and re-allot or to re-allot the lands described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

(Description of land specified in petition).

That portion of land extending 692 feet North of the Public Road and 692 feet South of the Public Road with a facade of about 2040 English feet and being bounded on the North by the remaining portion of Plantation Bush Lot or Lot No. 27, Corentyne, Berbice, on the East by the common boundary between Plantation Bush Lot or Lot No. 27 and Lot No. 28, on the South by the other remaining portion of Plantation Bush Lot or Lot No. 27, on the West by the Government Ketting — the said piece of land containing an approximate area of 68 English Acres, and being a portion of Plantation Bush Lot or Lot No. 27 as laid down and defined on a Plan of Plantation Bush Lot or Lot No. 27 by James A. P. Bowhill, Sworn Land Surveyor, dated the 16th February, 1918, and recorded in the Department of Lands and Mines as Plan No. 2600.
